# PRESIDENTS' NOTE

## September 2012

Where else would you rather be in the summer than in the Traverse City area? Summer has been busy with our many guests: friends, family, kids and grandkids. At a given point many of us probably felt like a vacation was needed from people on vacation. But the fun and enjoyment all add to the great lifestyle we enjoy up here. Summer is quickly coming to an end so it is time to start thinking about our activities for the upcoming year.

As of this date we have 305 members in Newcomers. This is an all-time high for our membership. Included in that number are 44 people who list themselves as single. That is an increase of eight people from last year. Our overall membership has increased by 36 since last year at this time. All of our events have been very well attended. This year the board anticipates continued growth, added activities, and continued involvement in community activities. Our members have represented the club by volunteering at the NMC BBQ, the State Theatre and the Cherry Festival.

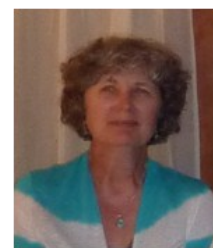
Success brings with it new issues and some challenges. Some of our events and/or programs draw up to 100 people. Not too many years ago, that was about the size of the whole club. We are financially sound, with enough money in the bank to insure that we can pay deposits for venues, food, and various other expenses that the Club incurs. This year the Board has decided to delay the date of the auction from November to May. The reasoning behind this is twofold. First, we think our members and the local merchants would appreciate a break from the auction and our bank account can handle it at this time. Second, many of the items in the auction involve summer activities, and we are anticipating we can get more activities and more bidding on these activities in the spring.

Many of you may not be aware that over the past few years, the club has subsidized many of our larger activities, such as the Kickoff dinner (\$10 per attendee), the Holiday party (\$10 per attendee) and the entire cost of the picnic. We anticipate we will be able to continue this for the 2012-2013 year. Without the income from the auction in November we will use up quite a bit of our reserves, but as a responsible board we are aware of our income and expenses. We will carefully review our fees for activities, our dues structure and our subsidies for events. We are a very successful club that has been operating for over 60 years. We must be doing a lot of things right.

Have a great year and let the fun begin.
